Some Important Background

The question may arise: which organizations are involved to execute this entire venture? Space does not allow us to provide complete information, so view the following as a summary:

- 1. The work on the ground, and the group that will be executing the church plant project on your behalf is a ministry called *Judea Harvest*. Their vision has always been to plant life-giving, self-sustaining churches across Africa. They focus on the communities where there are no churches and especially in communities where people have never heard the gospel. Taking the church to the people has always been their slogan and mission! The primary thing they do: Win souls for Christ, disciple them, and then connect them to new churches. Since 1999, they have: deployed 5,200 tents, planted more than 10,000 churches, trained 50,000 African leaders, and dispersed 39,000 solar charged audio Bibles with training material included.
- 2. The thrust behind Judea Harvest's church planting strategy is *ICM* (icm.org). They are closely involved in the *Snap Churches* project, mentioned previously, as well as the audio-format Bible study materials. ICM is reputable 501(c)3 organization with an impeccable reputation. Their mission is to partner globally with indigenous ministries to build churches and make disciples. (Please go to their website at icm.org.) One of ICM's great stories is with the Tanzania AG (TAG) under the leadership of Barnabas Mtakombali where they built over 550 churches. An ICM Quote: *We continue to look for opportunities to replicate the success of Tanzania within Africa. Judea Harvest is one of our main partners that is based in South Africa. They have been successful in applying our model within South Africa and a number of Africa nations.*
- 3. SpiritWind International (spiritwind.org) was established in 1995 and has been actively involved in South Africa since 2002. They have joined forces with Judea Harvest from the outset and were responsible for completely providing a tent factory for the purpose of manufacturing tents for the Kingdom. There have now been more than 5,000 tents distributed across Africa. SpiritWind has conducted numerous gospel crusades across Southern Africa with scores of people being saved and churches were planted. Several years ago, their emphasis changed to concentrating on Pastors and Leaders Conferences in South Africa where thousands of pastors gather annually. Their training and discipleship materials have been widely distributed in the USA and other countries.

We are anxious to get your congregation involved in what could be a once in a lifetime church planting opportunity.
